

Chamberlain Trail

Location: Trail-head is at the junction of Muskoka Road North and the Chamberlain Road approximately 1.7 kms north of the Gravenhurst Post Office at the Town centre.

Length: 3 kms

Facilities: roadside parking

Type of Trail: hiking, snowshoeing & biking

Surface Type: earth path, wood chip

Description: Be prepared to dodge wet areas! Trail features several marshy sections that have a Gothic appearance as well as large rock ridges that are great to explore. Close enough to town to hear the Segwun whistle but sunny meadows are perfect for a secluded picnic. Although this is a return trail, an extended residential walk can be found by turning right on Brydon's Bay Road. The contrasts of this trail are astounding as it travels from peaceful forests and craggy rock cuts to well-manicured lawns and flowerbeds. The return trek to the trail-head features a walk through an open meadow and a hard-track hardwood forest.
